Now Available: Pinot Noir Abel

Thought to have originated from the vineyards of Domaine de la Romanée-Conti in the Burgundy region of France, the highly acclaimed Abel clone of Pinot Noir has become synonymous with wines displaying outstanding complexity and depth.

The legend of the Abel clone can be traced back to the 1970's when a traveler attempted to return to New Zealand with cuttings he had acquired whilst visiting a vineyard in Burgundy.

The cuttings were discovered and confiscated by a Customs Officer named Malcolm Abel who, by coincidence, happened to be a winemaker. Understanding the significance of the discovery, Abel arranged for the cuttings to be put through quarantine. Abel then planted the cuttings in his vineyard at Kumeu just outside of Auckland and the rest, as they say, is history.
